After the parade, head to the Horseshoe Casino Stadium at Soulard Market Plaza for the nation's longest-running wiener dog derby. Known as "*the slowest two minutes in sports racing*," the six-dog elimination heats racing down a 30-foot track will each crown a winning wiener, who trots on to the next round until a champion is crowned.
